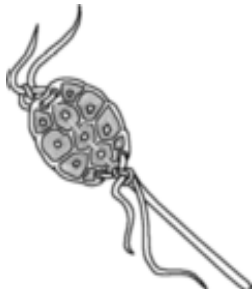

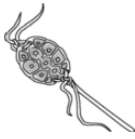

The following document is also required for applicants of the **Chickasaw Foundation Career Technology Scholarship:**

- A copy of your Chickasaw Nation employee identification badge.

The following document is requested for applicants of the **Chickasaw Foundation Health Professions Scholarship:**

- A copy of your CDIB (if applicable).

The following document is also required for applicants of the **Donald D. Gunning Memorial Scholarship:**

- Proof of income (most recent filed tax form).

The following documents are also required for law students applying for the **Judicial Scholarship – Law Student Scholarship** or the **Mitch Sperry Memorial Law Scholarship:**

- Proof of acceptance to law school and law school transcript (if applicable).

***Note:** Eligibility for receipt of the second disbursement of a two-part scholarship award (spring semester) shall be contingent upon remaining in full-time status and maintaining the minimum GPA requirement (based on preceding fall semester GPA). In the event any scholarship recipient is placed on academic probation, the recipient forfeits the scholarship award regardless of GPA requirement.

Students enrolled in on-line classes will be eligible to be considered for a scholarship award as long as the classes are associated with an accredited college or university.
